Dear Parent/guardian,

An exciting opportunity has arisen for Year 8 students to visit Bhaktivedanta Manor, the Hindu Community at Aldenham. This coincides with units of work studied as part of the RE curriculum. The visit will enable students to gain a greater understanding of Hindu life, prayer and sacred space. They will witness worship at the temple and take part in an exciting schedule of events led by the Educational Liaison Officers. This visit will enhance their learning and provide an invaluable opportunity to contextualise their study in the community.

Students will be accompanied by several members of staff from the school and will travel by coach to and from Bhaktivedanta Manor. We will depart at 8:45am and return around 3:45pm.

It is of the utmost importance that all students behave respectfully. They will be required to wear their normal school uniform.

The Hindu Community will be providing us with lunch, this will consist of a mild vegetarian curry (this does contain paneer cheese, made from cow's milk) rice, chips, flat bread, soft drink and fresh fruit. If there are any dietary restrictions, such as allergies, which exclude your child from lunch, please contact me to discuss alternatives.

The cost of the visit will be £22.50 per student; please return your **payment** along with the attached **lunch slip** and the enclosed **parental consent form** by 1 May at the latest.
