On Wednesday 20 March, our year seven, eight and nine students are being given the opportunity to take part in an hour long workshop on Gamelan music, the traditional music of Indonesia.

We are very lucky to have access to one of these instruments through Stevenage Music Service at The Nobel School and we have a specialist Gamelan tutor coming in for the day to lead the workshops. The workshops promise to offer a fascinating insight into a style of music that many of our students will never have listened to before, helping students to develop their aural and performance skills as well as encouraging their general musicality.

There will be three sessions with 15 students per session. Consequently, places will be offered on a first come first served basis.
