

Cultural Visit to the Royal Air Force Museum, Hendon on Saturday 23 March 2019

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We would like to offer the opportunity to go down to the Royal Air Force Museum on Saturday 23 March, leaving Nobel School at 9:30am and arriving back to school at approximately 4:30pm. We will be travelling on the school minibus so we can take up to 26 students. If there is greater interest then we could hire a coach. This trip is free for students attending.

This is an exciting opportunity to see the history of aviation in Britain and there are many hands-on exhibits about the First and Second World Wars. Facilities include three innovative galleries which explore the first 100 years of the RAF, its roles today and it invites visitors to imagine its future contribution and technology. Here three areas are covered –

- RAF stories: the first 100 years
- RAF: First to the future
- The RAF in an age of uncertainty

There is a café and several eateries in the museum so students can buy food if required. There is also a museum shop where students can buy souvenirs etc. if required, so some pocket money would be useful. Students will need to take a packed lunch and a waterproof jacket just in case they have to walk between the museum air hangars.
