Dear Parent,

I am writing to inform you of important dates and to remind you how to use the school's paperless system to access your child's data.

Wednesday 14 March 3:30-6:30pm is Year 12 Parents' Evening. This is an opportunity for you and your child to talk to subject staff about progress this year and what needs to be done to achieve the best possible grade in their examinations this summer.

Bookings for Parents' Evening will start in the week beginning 5 March and will be arranged between students and teachers; we will not be using the online booking system for this event. Each student will be given a booking card and will be responsible for arranging a time with each subject teacher. Please talk to your child about which time slots would suit you so that they arrange a time when you will be available.

Before this meeting I encourage you to look at the latest data available on your child using the school's VLE. The new data will go live on Thursday 8 March and you can access it using your usual login details. If you have not logged in before you can find instructions of how to access the system using the link below. A copy of this letter will also be emailed out and put onto the Sixth Form area of the website so that you can click on the link if you need to.


