Grammar: Conjugating Vivir in the Present Tense, using adjectives, using prepositions, choosing between 'ser' and 'estar', conjugating a few verbs into the Conditional Tense.</p> <p>Key Assessment Activity: Reading & Writing assessment: Based on new style GCSE</p>	<p>Mi Pueblo: My town Aim: To teach pupils how to ask and understand directions and describe a variety of shops and trades around town. Grammar: Imperative commands, a+ definite article, de+ definite article, numbers 31-100 and describing the weather in the Present Tense.</p> <p>Key Assessment Activity: Listening & Speaking (role play): Pupils ask directions and listen to responses</p>

<p>La Comida: Food and drink Aims: To introduce food and drink. Grammar: The past tense 'Preterite', numbers 100-1000, likes and dislikes, frequency, weights and measurements and discuss the Mediterranean diet.</p> <p>Key Assessment Activity: Writing assessment</p>	<p>El Turismo: Holidays Aims: To describe holidays and activities in a range of tenses. Grammar: modes of transport using en/a, irregular past tense of 'ir', conjugation of regular verbs in the past tense or 'Preterite'.</p> <p>Key Assessment Activity: Speaking assessments (Speaking card)</p>

Aims:
