		La Comida: Food and drink Aims: To introduce food and drink. Grammar: The past tense 'Preterite', numbers 100- 1000, likes and dislikes, frequency, weights and measurements and discuss the Mediterranean diet. Key Assessment Activity: Writing assessment to discuss the types of food that they prefer and why, reading longer texts in the past tense about other people's eating habits and answering questions based on that.	El Turismo: Holidays Aims: To describe holidays and activities in a range of tenses. Grammar: modes of transport using en/a, irregular past tense of 'ir', conjugation of regular verbs in the past tense or 'Preterite'. Key Assessment Activity: Listening and Speaking assessments: Pupils will verbally describe their holidays in the past, present and future using opinions and more complex sentences. Pupils will need to listen to extended responses and record their findings.

La Moda: Fashion Aims: To discuss clothing, school uniform and fashion. Grammar: Conjugating 'llevar' in different tenses, adjectives, conjugating the impersonal verb 'quedarle bien' and discussing opinions.	La salud: Health Aims: To discuss health and illness. Discussing healthy living and offering advice to others for health purposes. Vocabulary: Body parts, illnesses, Grammar: various ways of expressing "must".

Grammar: demonstrative pronouns, adjectives, 3x tenses, likes and dislikes, direct object pronouns and the set phrase 'dónde se puede' with a recap of clothes and food/drink items. Key Assessment Activity: End of Year assessments (Listening, Reading and Writing): Pupils will be tested on topics from all Modules throughout the year	El cine y la tele: Cinema and TV Aims: To focus on types of TV programmes and films in the cinema. Describing plots. Grammar: 3 tenses, directions, likes/dislikes and justification. Key Assessment Activity: Speaking role play: Pupils ask for cinema tickets.
