You may qualify for the Bursary Fund if you meet one of the following criteria.


- You have a low family income
- You can supply evidence of financial hardship that will impact on your son's or daughter's studies. Examples of such evidence include Tax Credit Award Statement (form TC602), evidence of Job Seekers Allowance, Housing Benefit or Income Support.

The funds available are limited and will be awarded to the students most in need.

If you would like to apply for this support then please complete the attached application form and return it with the appropriate supporting documentation as soon as possible. Applications will be considered by the school and awards decided upon the evidence supplied. Please be assured that all applications will be treated in the strictest confidence.
