KIT LIST WYMONDLEY WOOD

Students will require a packed lunch for the first day of their trip and we will be stopping on route to have a picnic. Students will be provided with a lunch for the return journey.

They will also need:

Waterproof anorak or cagoule

Warm sweatshirt / jumper

1 pair of tracksuit bottoms

2 pairs of trainers (one pair old) or wellies in case it is wet

2 T-shirts

1 pair of Shorts

1 large towels

Underwear / socks

Toilet bag and toiletries

Sunscreen

Sun hat / cap

A torch

Strong black sacks for wet or dirty clothes

One small plastic bottle / flask for carrying a drink

Small rucksack for carrying drink and lunch on first day and last day

One pair of pyjamas/sleepwear

Bedding – a sleeping bag and a pillow, role mat; extra blanket. This is to be packed in a black bin liner, clearly labelled with the students name

Tie-up black bin liner for bedding on return journey

Mug (plastic if possible) for hot chocolate.

Plate, knife, fork and spoon (plastic preferred)
