At Nobel, we aim to close the gap in achievement for those receiving PP funding and all other students. We draw on research from the EEF and the Sutton Trust toolkit as well as the barriers we have identified for our own students to allocate funding. There are many complex barriers for underachievement, however we have identified these explicit barriers for our students and have allocated funding to support: homework completion, school resources, cultural capital through a wide variety of trips, counselling and behavior therapy.

As research shows the best way to close the gap is through quality first teaching and a substantial proportion of funding is allocated to this.
