- Past holidays, including holidays when you were younger
- Describing accommodation
- Booking accommodation and dealing with problems
- Awful holidays
- Future and ideal holidays

Customs and Festivals

(Revision and extension from Year 7 unit 3)

- French traditions and customs: food and drink, mealtimes.
- Revisiting buying food, ordering in a restaurant, booking a table in a restaurant (role play)
- Talking about daily routine
- Comparing different festivals (Christmas...)
- How you celebrate using the past and present tenses. Describing a special day/event
- How did you used to celebrate?
- Talking about a film/music festival

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Unit 3

(Revision and extension from Year 8 unit 1)
