Knowledge and skills in dance assists in the creation of developed imaginative individuals whose experience of performing, collaboration and creativity will provide them with the knowledge they need to communicate effectively. Learning to co-operate in whole and small group work, concentration, commitment and mutual respect. Pupils embark upon a curriculum that pushes their technical and expressive skills. Using a variety of stimuli that provide them with the opportunity to develop their transferrable skills such as teamwork, co-operation and improving self-confidence. These skills are put into practice through a series of units that cover choreography, performance and appreciation. Students will complete their studies having learnt how to compose, perform, appraise, and collaborate. Whilst encouraging them to analyse and interpret through the freedom of their own expression.
