

## Week 6: Ratio

### What does it mean?

Ratio is the comparison of two or more quantities, expressed as the quotient: one divided by another.

For example:



When we make orange juice from a cordial mixture added to water, it may suggest – one part juice to four parts water.

This can be written as the ratio of juice to water as 1:4.

*It doesn't matter how big your glass or jug is, the ratio will still need to be 1:4.*

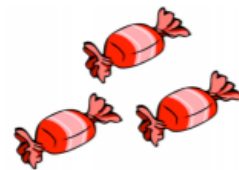
## **Problem Solving**

Ellie uses 250g of sugar and 650g of flour.  
Has Ellie used the correct ratio of sugar to flour?

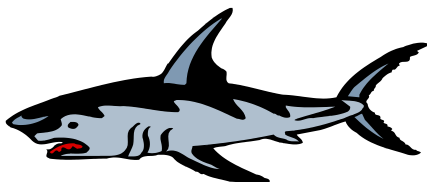


## **Weekly Challenge**
