The published admission number for external applicants is 30.

Admission Arrangements for Entry to the Sixth Form in September 2024

Two types of Level 3 qualification are offered at the Nobel School:

- 1. Advanced Level and
- 2. Applied General.

Students can study either type of qualification or a combination of the two. Entry onto these courses requires a minimum of a Grade 4 in both English Language and Maths.

## **Applications for entry to the Sixth Form**

The school will be consistent in the application of the published admission criteria and in the process of considering applications. This is to ensure fairness to all applicants. The criteria are based upon our professional judgement of what is required to ensure success on any course followed in our Sixth Form. See website for further information.

Students from other schools will be admitted provided they:

- 1. meet the entry requirements (see KS5 Entry Requirements) and
- 2. there are spaces available. The maximum number of places available in Year 12 is 170; the minimum number of these places open to external applicants is 30.

## **Over-subscription**

In the event that our Sixth Form is over-subscribed by external applicants, places will be offered as follows:

- 1. First to children in public care (children looked after) and children who were looked after, but ceased to be so because they were adopted (or became subject to a special guardianship order) as long as they meet the minimum entry requirement. Applications for children adopted but previously looked after abroad will be considered under this rule and accepted if the child's previously looked after status and adoption is confirmed. Hertfordshire's "Virtual School" will be asked to verify all such applications.
- 2. After this the decision will be based on distance from the school.
